Report of the Second Day (8th February 2022)







Report of Webinar on Digital Signal Processing for Audio Signals

The first day of the Webinar started with the Inaugural session which lasted for about an hour. The dignified webinar started with a welcome speech by Ms. Bhavya P V, Assistant Professor – Department of Computer and introduced the dignified chief guest of the webinar **Dr. P S Sathidevi**, Deputy Directory - NIT Calicut. Her topic was "Signals and Systems: An Overview". 





The objective of the first session of webinar was to discuss and impart fundamental knowledge about concepts in Linear Algebra and their applications in various fields like network security. Linear algebra provides concepts that are crucial to many areas of computer science, including graphics, image processing, cryptography, machine learning, computer vision, optimization, graph algorithms, quantum computation, computational biology, information retrieval and web search. Just like a solid foundation is essential to a building, linear algebra forms an essential learning segment for machine learning (ML). Areas of mathematics such as statistics and calculus require prior knowledge of linear algebra, which will help you understand ML in depth.

The second session handled by Dr Ali akbar on the topic 'Weierstrass Approximation and Applications. The Weierstrass approximation theorem states that every continuous function defined on a closed interval [a, b] can be uniformly approximated as closely as desired by a polynomial function. Because polynomials are among the simplest functions, and because computers can directly evaluate polynomials, this theorem has both practical and theoretical relevance, especially in polynomial interpolation. The original version of this result was established by Karl Weierstrass in 1885 using the Weierstrass transform. As a consequence of the Weierstrass approximation theorem, one can show that the space C[a, b] is weierstrass approximation theorem, one can show that the space C[a, b] is separable: the polynomial functions are dense, and each polynomial function can be uniformly approximated by one with rational coefficients; there are only countably many polynomials with rational coefficients. Since C[a, b] is metrizable and separable it follows that C[a, b] has cardinality at most 2x0.
